Newer small business routers are quick to install, easy to use and maintain, reducing the need for a dedicated IT team or administrator. Functions usually include options for management portals, security support, remote access, business gradeVPN (virtual private network), WAN redundancy, and expansion capacity, while sometimes limiting options for high speed, value or QoS features. If you did not understand the majority of the terms in that list, you will need to engage a network support company to assist you in the design, installation, upgrade and administration of your network.

- SonicWall : Originally a firewall but also fulfills many technical functions
- Cisco ASA : Originally a router company Cisco provide comprehensive solutions
- Sophos XG : Originally an anti-virus company, the Sophos appliance is a comprehensive hub for some networks
- Fortigate : Originally Fortinet sold firewalls but also fulfills many functions
