Epigraph

An epigraph marks a quotation placed at the beginning of a publication or chapter.

1. Provide the section with the title **Epigraph**, mark the title with a **Heading 1**.
2. Maintain all information in an introductory quote.

Prior to DAISY conversion, all epigraphs in the book will be coded as epigraphs (Farrah will do this).
