What you need

Before you can convert the cleaned-up DAISY XML file to a full-on book, be sure to download the following tools:

- [DAISY Pipeline 1](#) (for producing full DAISY)
- [DAISY Pipeline 2](#)
- [Yemuzip](#), [Keka](#), or a similar application to zip folders without the Mac-specific files
- [ttsbuilder.xml file and the main voices installed on your MacOS or Windows](#)

Optional: If you want to view the finished books then you'll need software that supports EPUB 3 with media overlays (i.e. Adobe Digital Editions) or full DAISY books (i.e. VoiceDREAM app, Dolphin EasyReader app).
